How to apply:

1. Complete the AFCOE Africa iSHARE application in this packet (or apply online at www.afcoeafrica.com).
2. Mail or deliver the completed application packet to AFCOE Africa (see address below). Ensure that you have read this entire packet, and signed that you are in harmony with the policy summary.
3. A completed application packet includes ALL of the following:
 - a) Completed AFCOE application form and admissions policies signed.
 - b) Two (2) student reference forms sent directly to AFCOE Africa by the individuals that filled them out – one reference from your pastor, and one from your head elder (Reference forms that arrive WITH a student application will not be accepted. These must come separately from those giving you a reference).

- c) Non-refundable processing fee of 500 KSh is charged before entering the iSHARE training (payable on registration day).
 - d) A recent photograph of yourself.
4. Applications will be reviewed for suitability.
 5. Applicants will receive a letter explaining the outcome of their application.
 6. AFCOE Africa introductory packs with guidance on what to do next, how to prepare and how to make payments will be sent to accepted students.
 7. A payment fee structure will be provided to all accepted applicants. Tuition is 10,000KSh plus the 500KSh application fee.
