How to apply:

- 1. Complete the AFCOE Africa iSHARE application in this packet (or apply online at www.afcoeafrica.com).
- 2. Mail or deliver the completed application packet to AFCOE Africa (see address below). Ensure that you have read this entire packet, and signed that you are in harmony with the policy summary.
- 3. A completed application packet includes ALL of the following:
 - a) Completed AFCOE application form and admissions policies signed.
 - b) Two (2) student reference forms sent directly to AFCOE Africa by the individuals that filled them out one reference from your pastor, and one from your head elder (Reference forms that arrive WITH a student application will not be accepted. These must come separately from those giving you a reference).



- c) Non-refundable processing fee of 500 ETB is charged before entering the iSHARE training (payable on registration day included in the initial payment).
- d) A recent photograph of yourself.
- 4. Applications will be reviewed for suitability.
- 5. Applicants will receive a letter explaining the outcome of their application.
- 6. A payment fee structure will be provided to all accepted applicants. Tuition is 5,000 ETB, which includes the 500 ETB application fee.

V. AFCOE Africa iSHARE ADMISSION POLICY

Please carefully read the following:

STUDENT COSTS:

The cost for the 10-Sunday, iSHARE course is 5,000 ETB which includes the entrance fee. This amount includes tuition, books, and lunch on Sundays.

Tuition Fee Structure:

For those who wish to make payments, the following is the fee structure for payments:

- First payment (due on arrival)	1,000 ETB
- Week #2	500 ETB
- Week #3	500 ETB
- Week #4	500 ETB
- Week #5	500 ETB
- Week #6	500 ETB
- Week #7	500 ETB
- Week #8	500 ETB
- Week #9	500 ETB



Payments must be made no later than Sunday morning each week by 9:00am, before being allowed to enter classes.

Refund policy

Cancellation Refund: All cancellations must be made in writing and mailed or emailed to AFCOE Africa not less than 30 days prior to the beginning of the program for a full refund for those paying in advance. Refunds will not be available for those on the payment plan.

Dismissal Refund: AFCOE Africa reserves the right to dismiss any student, without a refund, who consistently fails to abide by the policies and guidelines described in this admission policies document.
