3. A completed application includes ALL of the following:
 - a.) Completed AFCOE Africa application form signed and admissions policies signed.
 - b.) Three (3) student reference forms sent directly to AFCOE Africa by the individuals that filled them out (Reference forms that arrive WITH a student application will not be accepted. These must come separately from those giving you a reference).
 - c.) A recent photograph of yourself.
4. Applications will be reviewed for suitability.
5. Applicants will receive a letter or email explaining the outcome of their application.

6. AFCOE Africa acceptance letters with guidance on what to do next, will be sent to accepted students.
7. Course start date: 11 January, 2026
8. Visa Regulations: If you are coming from outside of Kenya, you should contact your local government and the Kenyan government, to determine visa requirements for spending six months in Kenya.
