

AFCOE Africa Sponsorship

(For College and University Students)



Requirements:

- 1) Applicant must be a Seventh-day Adventist in good and regular standing (must verify with copy of baptismal certificate).
- 2) Applicant must be between 18 and 30 years of age.
- 3) Applicant must be a current student at a college or university (copy of student ID required).
- 4) Applicant must have three positive references from the leadership of the local college or university church, where they attend during semester sessions.
- 5) Applicant must pay 2000KSh to enter the training. This must be paid by the student or their sponsors on or before the start date (21 Jan, 2018). The remaining 8500KSh for the program will be covered by Amazing Facts.
- 6) Applicant must make a commitment to complete the training, with the agreement to reimburse Amazing Facts in full, for all sponsorship moneys paid toward their training, up until the date when they dropped out of the program (i.e. if the student quits half-way through the training, they would reimburse 4500 KHs for the amount of sponsorship money paid toward their account, up to that date).
- 7) Applicant must maintain at least a “B” average in the AFCOE class assignments.
- 8) Applicant must commit to attend all Sunday classes (12 Sundays of training from 9:00 AM – 4:30 PM), or the make-up classes on Tuesday and Thursday evenings (6:00-9:00 PM).
- 9) Applicant must commit to follow AFCOE Africa policies and instructions.
- 10) Applicant must commit to conduct their practicum assignment (OJT – On-the-Job-Training) within one year of completing the classwork (the 12 Sundays of training).
